Minutes

Meeting April 20, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm. Dana Curry, Mack Duncan, Robert Schlebach, and Ed Wilson were in attendance. Micky Rouvaldt was absent from the meeting. Chief Briggs was in attendance. Motion was made by Mack Duncan and seconded by Robert Schlebach to approve the minutes. All approved. The financial report was reviewed. Robert Schlebach made a motion to approve, second by Mack Duncan, all approved. Bills were reviewed and paid.

Chief Briggs provided an update on the strategic plan with the Forney Fire Department. Chief Briggs went over the highlights of the report provided by Mike Pietsch, Consulting Services. The Fire Department is currently hiring new firefighters. The plans to move forward on expanding Station 2 and updating Station 1. There has been a restructure in the department. Philip Pyle will return as Captain and Holcomb will become Deputy Fire Chief. The property at the ESD station was considered to have a temporary housing and as reported in the past meeting, Talty Water is supportive of hainb placement. A motion was made by Robert Schlebach to approve temporary housing on the property for firemen during renovation, seconded by Dana Curry and all approved. The Consult report was reviewed and motion was made by Mack Ducan to accept the report, seconded by Robert Schlebach and all approved. Further decisions will be made in the near future regarding the recommendations in the report as with guidance and collaboration with Fire Chief Briggs and the City of Forney.

Early voting is underway. Marketing to provide information to the community has been circulating in social media and in mailers. Final results will be provided at the next meeting for action. As there was no other business, the meeting adjourned at 8:42 pm.
