Minutes

Meeting November 17, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 7:30pm. Dana Curry, Mack Duncan, Micky Rouvaldt, and Robert Ed Wilson were in attendance. Chief Briggs was also in attendance. Motion made by Micky Rouvaldt and second by Robert Schleich to approve minutes, all approved. The financial report was reviewed. Micky Rouvaldt made a motion to approve, second by Robert Schleich, all approved. Bills were reviewed and paid.

The update on the strategic plan with the city was addressed. Chief Briggs stated 7,502 dispatched calls in 2020-2021. 38% were in the ESD. The City is currently testing for new firemen. The City of Forney is working on a Bond package to go to election. Chief Briggs asked about the ESD partnering with the City for a consultant for a joint plan. Chief Briggs will explore potential firms and a proposed budget for the process and then present to the ESD. Chief Briggs asked for help on the documentation of hydrant maintenance in the ESD. The ESD assistant will contact the water districts in the ESD and ask for a RFQ and mapping. Dana Curry recommended for training to take place at the first of the year for Vivan Themer to be able to maintain uploads to the website. Mayes Media will be invited to an upcoming meeting to discuss updating marketing plans in preparation for the spring election. Katelyn Neill provided two ESD logo drafts. The board chose the one to be detailed and presented for final approval. As there was no other business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
